## What is it?

Upward Bound is a FREE program designed to prepare students for college.

Upward Bound was created in 1965 with the purpose to “provide educational opportunity for all Americans regardless of race, ethnic background, or economic circumstance.”

## How does it work?

The Upward Bound program has three main components: after-school tutoring, Saturday Academies, and a Summer Residential Program.

- After-school tutoring targets the academic aspect by providing individualized, remedial or enrichment opportunities.
- Saturday Academies: students are taking classes which provide them with the academic and social knowledge and support needed to enroll in College and succeed.
- The Summer Residential Program brings Upward Bound students to the South Plains College campus to live for five weeks to participate in intensive academic and personal growth activities.

## Who can Apply?

### Eligibility requirements:

1. Citizen or national of U.S., permanent resident, or provides evidence of intent to become a permanent resident.
2. Potential first generation college students (parents **have not** received a 4-year degree)
3. and/or meet low-income criteria
4. Or demonstrates need for academic support
